**Dental strand: Evaluation of Chairside Teaching**

The Subject Centre funded mini project *Chairside teaching and learning: stakeholders' perspectives* is nearing completion. The research team led by Jeff Wilson, John Sweet and Lesley Pugsley at University of Wales College of Medicine have been looking at the literature on chairside teaching and learning and carrying out an empirical study in Cardiff asking all stakeholders about how students learn. The team plan to take this study further and are hosting a dental strand of workshops at the Breaking Boundaries conference in November. There will be full opportunities for the discussion and presenting of ideas in a small group setting with less than 20 participants, and opportunities to engage in the wider conference proceedings

- B Chairside Teaching Perceptions – 9<sup>th</sup> November 15.30 – 17.00
